



General Meeting Minutes

May 19, 2022

The General Meeting was hosted by Rowlett PD at the Rowlett Community Center, 4401 Rowlett Rd., Rowlett, TX. The training topic was, “Child Safety”. The instructor was our very own 1st VP James Gordon. The training began at 10:03 am with the Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge of Allegiance led by NTCPA President Scott Voigt. Training ended at 11:40 am followed by lunch compliments of Rowlett PD.

The General Meeting was called to order at 11:45 am, by President Scott Voigt. He thanked Rowlett PD for hosting the training and providing lunch.
